Someone to Daydream About, by Sydney Langford ♥. Farrar, Straus, & Giroux (3/24/2026). A Deaf teen reluctantly takes a job teaching ASL to a spoiled boy band heartthrob ... but begins to have feeling for him. ⊌



Unravel, by Amelia Loken ♥ . Sword & Silk (2022). In a fantasy kingdom, a Deaf teen witch attempts to overthrow her tyrannical uncle, who kept her from learning sign and executes witches. ⊌



Hunting Sirens: A Gender-Flipped Little Mermaid, by Mary Mecham. Independently published (2023). A Deaf blacksmith (F), immune to the call of sirens, teams up with a mute siren (M) to save their peoples.
